POLICY STATEMENT

The following policy has been established for the Christian Formation Program at Saints Peter and Paul Parish.

1. Continuous religious education is vital to the program. Therefore, two years of consecutive attendance in Christian Formation classes is required in order to be admitted into the program for the reception of Sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist and three years of consecutive attendance for admission into the Confirmation Program.
2. Attendance at classes is important to the program. If a student is absent, a written note is needed when the student returns to class. If a student is absent for more than two classes, please notify the Catechist so that make-up work may be assigned.
3. Parents' support is necessary to the life of the Christian Formation Program. Parents are encouraged to assist their child with any religion tasks or projects assigned. Parents are required to attend the preparation programs conducted for them with regard to any sacrament in which their child will be enrolled. Parents are expected to attend the opening orientation meeting and end-of-the-year closing meeting. Your participation is critical for a collaborative effort, which enables us to serve and support your family's faith formation.

Your help and cooperation is vital to ensure quality religious education for our students. We provide the information and you provide the formation by regular Mass attendance as a family. This is an integral part of your child's religious development.
