



SUMMER BOOK REPORTS 2009-2010 ENTERING FIRST GRADE

To encourage continued interest in reading, Saints Peter and Paul Elementary School requires **TWO** book reports over the summer. The reports are due the first week of school. Since children are at different reading and writing levels, you may have to help them read their books or spell words for their sentences. Let them read as much as they can. Suggested authors are listed on the bottom of this letter.

Attached to this letter are Book Report forms and handwriting paper to be used for the reports. Please follow these steps, as you help your child with their work.

- 1. Choose a book.**
- 2. Read the book.**
- 3. Fill out the book report form with your child's name, title and author of the book.**
- 4. Have your child draw his or her favorite scene from the book. Please have your child draw the picture in pencil, and then color it with crayon.**
- 5. Have your child choose whether or not he or she liked the book. Your child should circle the appropriate words.**
- 6. On the attached handwriting paper, have your child write two sentences about the scene that he or she drew. The sentences should be written in pencil.**

These Book Reports will be graded. Help your child, but do not do the work for them. Encourage them to do their best work.

Have a safe, healthy, and fun-filled summer.

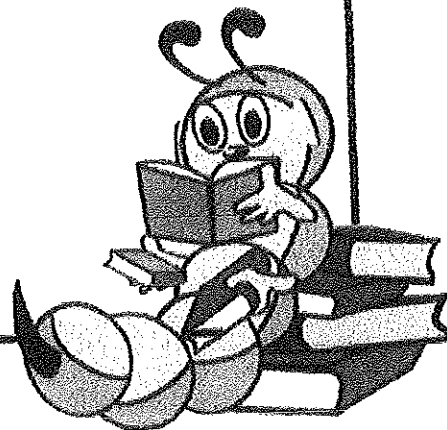

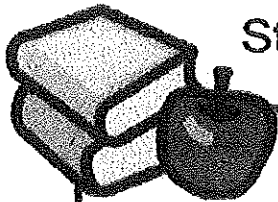

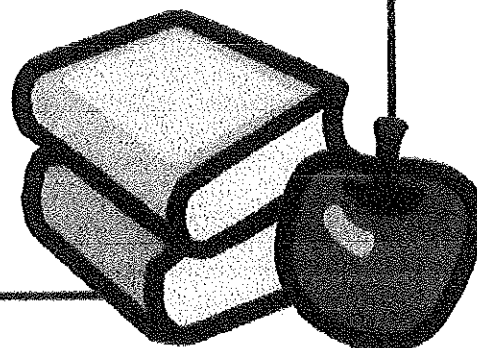
