

ACADEMIC/SCHEDULING POLICIES

COURSE SCHEDULING

Students will be scheduled for a seven-class academic program each semester. Only when scheduling constraints preclude scheduling a student into a seventh course will study halls be considered.

PLACEMENT/MOVEMENT

Students are placed into Honors/Advanced Placement courses based on the criteria published for each course. In general, students are only advanced a maximum of one level over the previous year. Parents/students desiring a lower placement may request such. Any student who scores below a 70% during the first semester of an Honors/Advanced Placement course will be considered for movement to a lower level course for the second semester.

ADD/DROP

Students/parents may request changes in student schedules up through the first two weeks of semester. Adding or dropping of courses will not be considered after that time. Each student is expected to pass every course in which he or she is enrolled. **Poor performance will not be considered as a reason for dropping a course.**

OUTSIDE TUTORING

Saints Peter and Paul High School recognizes parents may at times feel that outside tutoring will be beneficial for their student. However, outside tutoring should be used only as a supplement to traditional coursework and should be coordinated with the classroom teacher to insure optimum use of the resource. **Outside tutoring by itself may not be considered for either original or remedial credit.**
