Saints Peter and Paul High School Students Named AP Scholars

Easton, MD – Four students at Saints Peter and Paul High School have earned AP Scholar Awards in recognition of their exceptional achievement on AP Exams.

Christopher Hiers '10 and Brittany Stauch '11 were all recognized as AP Scholars by completing three or more AP Exams with grades of 3 or higher while Alec Graham '10 and Katie Witwer '10 were recognized as an AP Scholar with Distinction for earning an average grade of least 3.5 on all AP Exams taken and grades of 3 or higher on five or more of these exams.

The College Board's Advanced Placement Program (AP) provides motivated and academically prepared students with the opportunity to take rigorous college-level courses while still in high school, and to earn college credit, advanced placement, or both for successful performance on the AP Exams. About 18 percent of the nearly 1.8 million students worldwide who took AP Exams performed at a sufficiently high level to also earn an AP Scholar Award.
