

## **PSA Minutes**

### **January 14, 2008**

President Nancy Lenkiewicz opened the meeting with a prayer

Treasurer's report: Nancy Lenkiewicz gave a review of the money brought by several fundraisers.

### **New Business:**

1. Yankee Candle Fundraiser – Mrs. Lenkiewicz reported that the company sent a letter apologizing for the numerous backorders and broken items that are out of character for their company. They attributed the problems to a new facility and a new computer system.
2. Greenery Sale – Other than the delay in receiving the order forms, Mrs. Lenkiewicz said the sale went very well.
3. Spirit Wear – Mrs. Lenkiewicz wanted to make all of the parents aware that the PSA now has visors, caps, girl's hair ribbons and several sizes of sweatshirts in stock. Also, She is looking for 1 volunteer to help sell spirit wear during the Grandparents Luncheon.
4. Catholic Schools Week – The Teacher's Appreciation Breakfast is Friday, February 1<sup>st</sup>. Room Moms are supposed to sit with the students while the teachers are having their breakfast from 7:45-8:30. Also, Mrs. Lenkiewicz will need 3 volunteers for a couple of hours to pour soda during the Grandparents Luncheon.
5. Tupperware Sale - The Tupperware Sale has been shelved for the time being. The majority of the parents agreed that the items are a little too expensive and that most parents just buy the disposable versions, such as GladWare. There was also a problem with scheduling the sale, since there are multiple events coming up already.

6. Casino Night – Rob Lacaze held his first meeting and the committees were formed. Flyers will be coming out soon with the details. This year's Casino Night will be held Saturday, April 12<sup>th</sup> beginning at 6:00p.m. The tickets are \$65.00. Just like last year, there will be a cash bar, appetizers, silent auction, live auction – including a car, and gaming tables which will open at 7:00p.m.
7. Family Fun Night – Colleen Gabler reported that Family Fun Night will be Friday, February 1<sup>st</sup>. The doors open at 5:30p.m., so that families can have ample time to purchase snacks. There will be hot dogs, cotton candy, soda, water and popcorn. All snacks are \$1.00 each and can be purchased throughout the entire event. Two movies will be shown, one at 6:00p.m., and one at 8:00p.m. The titles of the movies will be in this weeks update. Also, a sign up sheet will be sent out that parents must respond to if planning to attend, because the space will fill up quickly. Mrs. Gabler cautioned that this is not an activity that you can show up to last minute.
8. Elementary School Update – Mrs. Webster reported that the next big event for the school will be Catholic Schools Week and all of the planning for that is on track. Mrs. Webster also made the PSA aware of the school's long range plans. She said that there are funds that will be used for renovating the chapel. She plans to update the teacher's/aide's desks. The security system plans are still in the works and there are also plans to upgrade the computers.
