

## **PSA Minutes**

### **January 12, 2009**

President Beth Chatham opened the meeting with a prayer.

Treasurer's Report: Jenny Carrieri gave an update on the proceeds from the various fundraisers to date.

#### **New Business:**

1. Teacher Appreciation Breakfast: The room moms will be responsible for coverage in the classrooms from 7:45-8:30 on January 30<sup>th</sup>.
2. Rummage Sale: The Rummage Sale Fundraiser will be held on May 16<sup>th</sup> from 7-12 a.m. If the weather is nice, we will be outside. If not, we will use the cafeteria. Donations will be accepted no earlier than 2 days prior to the sale for storage reasons. Beth Chatham will send out a list of acceptable items to donate at a later date.
3. 2009/2010 Committee Chairs and Officers: Please let Beth Chatham know if you are interested in chairing a committee next year. Also, anyone currently chairing a committee needs to let Beth know if they are not available to do so next year. The magazine drive still needs a co-chair.
